THE PAZNAUN VALLEY IN A NUTSHELL


The Paznaun valley is a sun-drenched high valley in western Tyrol, bordering with the province of Vorarlberg to the southwest and Switzerland to the south. Dotted around the 40-kilometre valley, the four villages of See, Kappl, Ischgl and Galtür are located between 1,056 and 1,584 metres above sea level. Surrounded by the impressive Verwall mountains to the north and the Silvretta and Samnaun mountains to the south, the region boasts stunning ski slopes and cross-country trails in winter and scenic hiking trails, (e-)bike routes and climbing spots in summer. What's more, the Paznaun valley is known for its exquisite culinary delights ranging from traditional Tyrolean dishes to haute cuisine served at the region's mountain lodges and fine-dining restaurants. With accommodations to suit any budget, a thermal spa, vibrant traditions, top-notch concerts, as well as exciting festivities and sports events for both participants and spectators, the Paznaun valley stands out as one of Austria's most vibrant and diverse holiday destinations.

Thanks to its favourable location, the Paznaun valley gets abundant sunshine and consistent snow throughout the winter. Until early May, families, winter sports enthusiasts, foodies and party-goers can enjoy a wide range of sports, events and entertainment options. Four diverse ski areas with numerous ski runs located above 2,000 metres offer a combined total of 366.5 kilometres of slopes as well as excellent fun parks and powder spots for freeriders. One of them is Silvretta Arena ski resort, one of the largest cross-border ski areas of the Alps. It boasts 90 winter hiking trails, 80 kilometres of cross-country ski trails, three toboggan runs, two ice skating rinks, several ice climbing spots, lively après-ski and nightlife entertainment, Silvretta Therme spa in Ischgl and ten fine-dining restaurants. Event highlights include four legendary "Top of the Mountain Concerts" featuring international acts, the "Shapes in White" snow sculpture competition in Ischgl and international freeride contests in Kappl.

In the sun-drenched Paznaun valley, families and active guests enjoy carefree summer holidays full of breathtaking mountain vistas, culinary delights, vibrant traditions and heartfelt Tyrolean hospitality. Unforgettable outdoor activities, top-notch concerts, special culinary festivals and exciting participatory events such as the Paznaun Ischgl Ultra Trail, the E-Bike World Cup for Everyone and the Ischgl Ironbike top off the holiday experience. While the spectacular single tracks of lively Ischgl attract mountain bike enthusiasts from all over the world, avid climbers, boulderers and bike-loving families feel right at home at the traditional health resort of Galtür. Kappl and See are popular with guests for their numerous possibilities for outdoor activities, fun in the water and countless family highlights. All four locations boast a diverse landscape with an extensive network of hiking and (e-)biking trails, scenic walking routes and via ferratas for all skill levels.
