

Winter entertainment and lifestyle in Ischgl

Ischgl not only offers a first-class ski resort in winter, but also a comprehensive range of entertainment and an upscale lifestyle. The resort is known for its combination of winter sports, exclusive events, gourmet restaurants and après-ski, offering every visitor an unforgettable experience.

Concerts and events

Ischgl organises high-calibre events all year round, and the region is a cultural hotspot in winter in particular. The biggest events include the Top of the Mountain Concerts, which bring international stars to the stage at the opening and closing of the season. These concerts, which take place at an altitude of 2,300 metres on the Ischgl Stage on the Idalp, offer a spectacular combination of music and Alpine panorama. Stars such as Elton John, Robbie Williams and the Black Eyed Peas have played in front of thousands of skiers and music fans in the past.

Another highlight is Spring Blanc, a series of events in April combining spring skiing and concerts. This series of events is aimed at skiers who want to enjoy the last days of the season in Ischgl with music and sunshine. It includes the Top of the Mountain Spring, Easter and Closing Concert, as well as culinary highlights such as the sun.downer, grenzenlos.kulinarisch and the dine.around.

Silvretta Therme - wellness and relaxation

The Silvretta Therme, which will open in 2022, is a particularly luxurious wellness centre in Ischgl. The spa area covers an area of 1,000 m² with indoor and outdoor pools, children's pool, sports pool and more. The highlight is the heated outdoor pool with pool bar and panoramic views of the surrounding Alps. The 1,500 m² sauna area at the thermal spa offers eight different saunas and steam baths, an outdoor pool, snow grotto, sauna garden and modern relaxation zones. Two Austrian sauna masters and home-made infusions round off the offer.

In addition to classic wellness treatments and a private spa, the thermal spa also has a modern fitness studio where guests can exercise and a physiotherapy practice. The thermal spa also offers space for a 1,300 m² ice skating rink on the first floor and an event hall. The thermal spa also boasts five restaurants serving healthy, high-quality food, which ideally round off the wellness programme.

Exclusive hotels and fine dining

Ischgl is known for its luxurious accommodation offering the highest level of comfort and service. Many hotels in the region have spacious wellness areas, first-class gastronomy and extensive leisure facilities. Particularly noteworthy in Ischgl is the high density of gourmet restaurants and award-

winning restaurants in the region, some of which have received multiple awards and offer an exquisite culinary experience.

Après-ski and nightlife

Ischgl has established itself as one of the leading après-ski resorts in the Alps. After skiing, the socialising begins in numerous bars and clubs right in the village. The atmosphere is characterised by an exuberant atmosphere, international music and a variety of entertainment options that last late into the night. The après-ski culture in Ischgl often starts in the early afternoon and offers the right party option for every taste. From traditional lodges with typical music to modern clubs with DJs playing electronic music, there is a wide range of entertainment.
